<head></head>	Contains meta-information about the document, such as title, charset, and linked stylesheets.

> Defines a paragraph of text. Creates hyperlinks to other web pages or resources. **<Q**> Embeds images in the document. Defines an unordered (bulleted) list. <l (O) Defines an ordered (numbered) list. (i) Represents list items within or lists. <div> A container used for grouping and styling elements. An inline container used for grouping and styling text or inline elements. Defines a table structure to organize data. Represents a table row within a . Defines a table header cell (typically in the first row).



Represents a standard table data cell. <form> Used to create a form for user input. Creates various form input fields (text, radio <input> buttons, checkboxes, etc.). <a>Associates a label with an <input> element. <texturea> Defines a multi-line text input field. **(button)** Creates a clickable button within a form. **<select>** Generates a dropdown list for selecting options. <option> Defines an option within a <select> element. Embeds an inline frame for displaying external <iframe> content. Embeds audio content with controls for <audio> playback. **<video>** Embeds video content with playback controls.



Provides a blank canvas for dynamic graphics using <canvas> JavaScript. Embeds scalable vector graphics. <svg> <footer> Represents the footer of a document or section. Defines the header section of a document or <header> section. Marks a navigation menu or links within a <nav> document. Defines an independent, self-contained piece of <article> content. Used for content that is tangentially related to the <aside> surrounding content. Represents contact information, typically for the <address> author of the document. Creates a thematic break or horizontal line in a (hr) document.
 Inserts a line break within text or content. Contains image map coordinates and clickable <map> areas.
